



Upon the application of Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP, Counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Fabrics Estate Inc. (f/k/a Propex Inc.), et al., for Interim Allowance of Compensation and for the Reimbursement of Expenses for Services Rendered During the Period from February 1, 2009 Through May 31, 2009 (the "Application");<sup>1</sup> and it appearing that the relief requested is in the best interest of the Debtors' estates, their creditors and other parties in interest; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that venue of this proceeding and the Application in this District is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing that notice of the Application and the opportunity for a hearing on the Application was appropriate under the particular circumstances and that no other or further notice need be given; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Application is granted in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED that Akin Gump is allowed interim (a) compensation in the amount of \$322,456.50 for necessary professional services rendered during the period commencing February 1, 2009 through and including May 31, 2009, (b) reimbursement in the amount of \$27,477.91 for expenses incurred during the period commencing February 1, 2009 through and including May 1, 2009; (c) compensation in the amount of \$132,714.50 for necessary professional serves rendered in connection with the BNP Adversary Proceeding; and (d) reimbursement in the amount of \$6,565.38 for the expenses incurred by GCG during the period

commencing January 1, 2009 through and including April 30, 2009 while serving as the official communications agent for the Committee; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors are authorized and directed to pay Akin Gump all unpaid fees and expenses awarded under this Order, without any holdbacks; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors are authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Order in accordance with the Application; and it is further

ORDERED that the terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry; and it is further

ORDERED that the Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
