**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF JAMES SAVIN IN CONNECTION
WITH THE RETENTION OF AKIN GUMP STRAUSS HAUER & FELD LLP
BY THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS**

JAMES SAVIN, hereby declares:

1. I am an attorney at law admitted to practice before the state courts of New York, the United States District Courts for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York, and the United States District Court for the District of Columbia. I am a member of the firm of Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP (“Akin Gump”), which maintains offices at 1333 New Hampshire Avenue, N.W., Washington, DC 20036.


2. I am familiar with the matters set forth herein. In connection with Akin Gump’s representation of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (“the Creditors’ Committee”) of Propex Inc. (“Propex”) and its affiliated debtors and debtors in possession (collectively with Propex, the “Debtors”), I make this supplemental declaration in regard to Akin Gump’s

obligation to update its disclosures as set forth in the Application to Employ Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP as counsel to the Creditors' Committee, which this Court approved pursuant to an order entered on February 27, 2008.

3. Akin Gump has recently staffed an associate, Robert Ozols, to the team of Akin Gump attorneys working on behalf of the Creditors' Committee in the Propex cases. Mr. Ozols was formerly an associate at King & Spalding LLP ("King & Spalding"), which is lead bankruptcy counsel for the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases. Mr. Ozols was employed by King & Spalding from September 2006 to March 2008. While at King & Spalding, Mr. Ozols spent approximately five hours of time working on matters pertaining to the Propex cases. King & Spalding has been contacted about the decision to staff Mr. Ozols on these cases and has waived any conflict, provided that Akin Gump does not inquire as to the substantive nature of the work that Mr. Ozols performed and Mr. Ozols does not otherwise disclose such information.

I hereby declare under the penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
